



POLICY REGARDING CHILDREN

As Conklin continues to grow, the policy regarding National Convention will be consistent with the policy of all of our corporate training programs, allowing for the best Convention experience for everyone.

Effective with the 2015 Conklin National Convention, children under the age of 13 are not permitted to attend any part of the National Convention, including the President's Club Dinner, Friday night entertainment and the Gala Banquet. Children 13 and older who would like to attend general sessions, workshops and product exhibits must have a paid registration/name badge in order to gain entry into these events. Tickets will be available to purchase for children 13 and older who want to attend Friday night entertainment and/or the Gala Banquet only.

For liability, safety and security reasons, the Hiltons of Branson & Convention Center have requested that no children are to be left unattended in sleeping rooms or public spaces throughout the facility, including elevators and/or escalators. Children under the age of 13, including infants, will not be allowed in the pre-function space outside the Taneycomo Ballroom or on the main concourse where all Convention-related activities are scheduled.

While families are very important to us, the Conklin National Convention is considered to be an annual business meeting and adult training event. The National Convention experience allows our Distributors to network with Conklin leaders from across the nation, participate in informative workshops, learn from dynamic speakers, celebrate successes with top Conklin leaders and set goals for the upcoming year.
